Read each sentence and decide if it is correct or incorrect in grammar, spelling or punctuation. If the sentence is correct, follow the arrow to a blue place.

If it isn't correct, follow the arrow to a red place.

Try to reach the finish line by checking each of the sentences.

Here are the sentences:

1. There are rarely any apostrophes in plurals, if ever.
2. Their are many ways to get to the end of this maze.
3. If I where you, I'd like to work out my own grammar maze.
4. Probably sooner rather than later you will get to the end.
5. This looks like it is going to be a quick activity.
6. Do you think you could write more than six sentences for your own maze?
